# The Cottage Queen

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*Not every Victorian house was a grand estate. The Queen Anne cottage brought the style's ornamental vocabulary — turned porch posts, jigsaw bargeboard, fish-scale gable — to a more modest scale without sacrificing any of its character. The climbing roses on the trellis here are doing double duty: softening the facade and framing the entry in the way Victorian landscape guides explicitly recommended.*
